

**Erick Olson**  
Comedy Magic Show Rider

Thank you for inviting Erick to entertain at your event. Your assistance in providing a few essentials will be greatly appreciated.

**Staging** – If you are creating a stage, please have it measure no less than 8'x12' deep. If performance area is a platform stage, make sure they are securely fastened together with stairs that are centered and facing the audience. The stage area should be smooth, level, clean and free of visual obstruction. Erick can provide back drops for stage if not in place already. **Important: Audience must be located in front of the stage with no dance floor between seats and performance area.** Please tape or rope off the back half of the seats to keep the audience close to the stage (the house manager will open rows as the Theatre fills). Seating is critical to the success of any show. **Important: Please notify us prior to show day if there will be other performers using the stage.**

**Sound** – If you are providing sound, Erick will need a hand held wireless. If there is no sound system, Erick can provide a portable sound system good up to 150 guests. (Local shows only)

**Lighting** – The existing room lighting is often sufficient. One or two follow spots with an experienced operator from the back of the room can make a huge impact.

**Show Requirements** – Please provide one bar stool (preferably) or chair.

**Access** – Please have the space available 60 minutes prior to guest arrival for proper set-up.

**Dressing Room** – When available, please provide a private and secure room near the performance area. The room should have a mirror, table, chair, and two (2) bottles of water and a bathroom nearby.

**Collateral Use** – The show cannot be videotaped, photographed or filmed without advanced written permission from Erick Olson. Please provide a copy of all advertisements, press, posters, handbills, marketing and review of the performance.

**Introduction** – Erick has appeared and disappeared throughout the United States, Japan and Canada. You might recognize him from America's Got Talent, just back from the Bellagio Hotel and Casino in Las Vegas where he had a wonderful stay.
